

COMMUNITYEDU INFORMATION

Phi Sigma Kappa is proud to partner with Vector Solutions an education technology company, to provide our associate members with education on topics such as alcohol and other drugs, hazing, mental health, diversity equity and inclusion, and sexual assault. The Grand Chapter believes in the safety and well-being of all members and want our associate members to start their Phi Sig journey in a positive way. Many college campuses and national fraternity/sorority headquarters partner with Vector Solutions to educate their students on healthy behaviors and decision-making.

Details regarding the CommunityEdu process:

- All associate members need to complete Part 1 and Part 2 prior to initiation.
- Associate members need to validate their information and create their myPhiSig account as soon as possible after the Ritual of Association.
- Associate members should receive an email from EVERFI to the email address that is in Officer Portal, within a week or so of them validating their account.
- This email's subject line will say "CommunityEdu assigned to you by Phi Sigma Kappa."
- They should click their individual, unique link in that email to set up their account with CommunityEdu.
- After they set up the account, they can access CommunityEdu through myPhiSig.
- Part 1 should be completed within the first two weeks of the associate member process.
- Part 2 is just a short survey and should be completed prior to Ritual for the Initiation of New Members.
- Plan accordingly. CommunityEdu is designed to capture change over time data and includes a three-week (21 day) intercession period between the completion of Part 1 and when Part 2 will be available.
 - Chapters should aim to have all associate members complete Part 1 within the first two weeks to make sure they have enough time to complete Part 2 before initiation.
 - International Headquarters professional staff will not provide overrides for associate members who have not completed CommunityEdu requirements before their initiation date unless there is an extenuating circumstance.
- Inductors and Secretaries can check associate members' CommunityEdu status through Officer Portal, under the "request initiation" button under the "Members" tab.
- For questions or issues with CommunityEdu, chapters can reach out to their IHQ chapter coach for assistance.
